


# HOMETOWN HEROES



## BANNER PROGRAM™

The City of Northfield Hometown Heroes Banner Program is a living tribute created for the community to recognize and honor our Northfield Veterans who are serving or who have served our Country in a branch of the United States Armed Forces.



To qualify, a Veteran, living or deceased, must have a connection to the City of Northfield (lived in the City of Northfield, attended a Northfield school, etc.) at some point in his or her life.

### Banner description:

- A 18"x36" banner
- Constructed on 22 oz heavy weight block out vinyl
- Double sided print along with aluminum mounting brackets
- Will display Honoree's photograph, name, rank and branch of military, era of service, and medal (if applicable)
- Displayed from Memorial Day through Veterans Day, in the year of purchase, along the Bike Path
- Will be removed and stored until the same period the following year at which time they will be re-displayed (flags will be returned to family after 2 years in 'as is' condition)

### Each banner requires:

- Completed Hometown Hero Application (located in Clerk's Office at City Hall or on the City website: [www.cityofnorthfield.org](http://www.cityofnorthfield.org), on the 'forms' tab on the City Services page)
- A photograph of the hero in uniform (150 dpi @ full size image) submitted on flash drive
- A payment of **\$185.00** for each banner (includes brackets) made payable to **"City of Northfield"** with Hometown Hero Banner in the MEMO section
