

ATTENTION RESIDENTS

On Wednesday, January 23, 2019, the complete reconstruction of the Davis Avenue sanitary sewer pumping station (at the end of Second Street) will begin. The work is being done for the City of Northfield and will require a temporary pumping system to be set-up in the northeast (NE) section of the intersection of Davis Avenue and Second Street. A temporary 8" pipe will run from the NE intersection of Davis Avenue and Second Street - on the road surface along the northeast curb line - to a bypass connection closer to the pump station at the end of Second Street.

Construction equipment and trucks will use Second Street to access the work area, which is at the end of Second Street, during normal working hours. (7:30 am – 4:00 am)

Beginning at 7:30 am on Wednesday, January 23, 2019, parking along the north curb line of Second Street will be prohibited for the duration of the bypass pumping. Parking along the south curb line will be permitted from the stop sign to the last driveway. The work is anticipated to last to approximately the middle of February.
