

ORDINANCE 16-2010

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TWO HOUR PARKING
ON A PORTION OF CEDAR BRIDGE ROAD FROM JUNIPER DRIVE
TO WABASH AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield desires to improve the parking situation around the Northfield Community School; and

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield Ordinance 6-2009, was adopted, in pertinent part, to make it unlawful for any person who is not a resident of Cedar Bridge Road between Route 9 (New Road) and Juniper Drive to park a motor vehicle on said street for more than two hours as more fully set forth in said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City of Northfield has recommended that two hour parking be put into effect on the portion of Cedar Bridge Road between Juniper Drive and Wabash Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield desires to improve the traffic congestion around the Northfield Community School and desires to follow the recommendations of its police department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Northfield, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person who is not a resident of Cedar Bridge Road between Juniper Drive and Wabash Avenue to park a motor vehicle on said street for more than two hours.

Section 2. The above stated restrictions as to two hour parking on Cedar Bridge Road shall only apply when the Northfield Community School is in session. Furthermore, said restrictions shall apply between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on those days when the Northfield Community School is in session.

Section 3. A resident shall be defined as an individual who resides in a house on Cedar Bridge Road or Juniper Drive and the car that is parked in the street is in fact registered to said household. These individuals are exempted from complying with the two hour parking restriction.

Section 4. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction in the Municipal Court of the City of Northfield, be fined an amount not exceeding \$200.00.

Section 5. This Ordinance and amendment to the Code of the City of Northfield shall become effective upon final adoption and publication as prescribed by law.
