

**CITY OF NORTHFIELD, NEW JERSEY
ORDINANCE 8-2017**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 220, ARTICLE V, OF THE
CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD, GOVERNING LICENSED
OCCUPATIONS, AS AMENDED BY RESOLUTION NO. 129-2017 ON
MAY 30, 2017**

WHEREAS, City of Northfield Code Section 220 governs Licensed Occupations in the City of Northfield; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Northfield desires to amend certain sections/sub-sections of Chapter 220; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Northfield, County of Atlantic, and State of New Jersey that Chapter 220 of the Code of the City of Northfield is hereby amended as follows (added text underlined; deleted text stricken):

Chapter 220 – Licensed Occupations

Article V – Regulations for Certain Licenses

§ 220-34 Peddlers

- D. From October 1st to March 31st no person shall sell, offer for sale, hock or peddle at any private residence or on any public roadway within the City of Northfield at any time before 9:00 a.m. or after 7:30 p.m. nor at any time on Sunday or a holiday.

From April 1st to September 30th, No person shall sell, offer for sale, hock or peddle at any private residence or on any public roadway within the City of Northfield before 9:00 a.m. or after 8:30 p.m.

§ 220-36 Transient merchants.

- A. No Change

- C. From October 1st to March 31st, no sale or solicitation activity shall be carried on by any transient merchant, itinerant merchant or itinerant vendor at any private residence or on any public roadway within the City of Northfield before 9:00 a.m. or after 7:30 p.m. on weekdays and Saturdays. No such activity shall be carried on at any time on Sundays or holidays.
- D. From April 1st to September 30th, no sale or solicitation activity shall be carried on by any transient merchant, itinerant merchant or itinerant vendor at any private residence or on any public roadway within the City of Northfield before 9:00 a.m. or after 8:30 p.m.

REPEALER: All Ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent in whole or in part with the provisions contained herein are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.

SEVERABILITY: If any portion of this ordinance shall be determined to be invalid, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of said ordinance.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
