TAKE NOTICE that the City of Northfield in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey is contemplating the engagement of a grant writer to obtain grants, public, private or other, to assist the City of Northfield fund certain projects and acquisitions to be identified, including but not limited to the construction of curbs and sidewalks along certain streets and roads in the City of Northfield in need of those improvements if and when the City of Northfield decides to fund and proceed with said projects and acquisitions. Be advised that the City of Northfield is merely in an investigatory and information gathering stage. This request for information shall not be considered to be a contract solicitation or binding upon the City of Northfield in any manner whatsoever. Nor shall it obligate the City of Northfield to proceed any further with a request for qualifications, proposals, competitive bidding or public contracting. Be further advised that the City of Northfield has made no appropriations in the City of Northfield's 2013 budget for these projects and acquisitions. Accordingly, no official action whatsoever is expected to occur in 2013. The City of Northfield may in its sole and absolute discretion, but shall not be obligated to, make appropriations in the 2014 or subsequent budgets for these potential projects and acquisitions following the current investigatory and information gathering stage.

1. Names of individual grant writers and their respective employers interested in potentially providing grant writing services to the City of Northfield if and when the City of Northfield decides to proceed.
 - a. Identify the person(s) who will be primarily responsible for these services and provide a detailed description of the experience and specific knowledge the primary person has with public, private, corporate and other grant writing projects and issues similar to those that may be undertaken on behalf of the City of Northfield. Attach a resume.
 - b. Identify person(s) who will serve as support and backup to the primary person. Attach a resume.
2. Provide a detailed written explanation of the process through which a grant writer obtains funds for a client from:

- a. public grant sources;
 - b. private grant sources;
 - c. corporate grant sources; and other grant sources.
3. Provide a detailed written explanation of the process by which a grant writer is paid for obtaining grant funds from public, private, corporate and other grant sources. Include all types of fee arrangements and methods of payment including but not limited to payment/compensation on a percentage basis, contingent basis, hourly rate basis and/or any other acceptable methods of payment/compensation to the grant writer for successfully obtaining grant funds.
4. Provide detailed information concerning the grants that the grant writers have successfully obtained on behalf of clients including:
 - a. client name;
 - b. type of grant;
 - c. purpose of grant;
 - d. source of grant;
 - e. amount of grant; and
 - f. method of compensation to grant writer.
5. List of references:
