2) You will need to provide your own decorations for your trunk. All displays must include a decorated vehicle with costumed adults. Cars participating in the event, must be turned off during the event time slot.

Keep in mind this is a family event & all decorations should be appropriate for children 0-12....

Please avoid overly scary displays & costumes! Please note... electricity is available.

- 3) One responsible adult must be present at each vehicle at all times during the event
- 4) We ask that you please provide us with a Certificate of Insurance for your organization and current vehicle insurance for each vehicle participating with a limit of 2 per location (vehicle must be registered and insured).
- 5) Each organization is responsible to provide a sealed individually wrapped candy or treat. Please come prepared with at least 1,000 items to ensure that every child gets one piece or treat!
- 6) Registered participants may check in to the designated parking spaces at 1:45pm to set up!
- 7) All whicles must remain in their spots until the conclusion of the event... you may begin un-decorating at 7:15 pm, but must wait until 7:30 pm to exit (or until the Police deem it safe to begin exiting)...
- 8) Upon completion of the event, please insure the area around your treat stop is clean & all trash removed prior to leaving.

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HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT Schedule of Insurance

Notwithstanding the indemnification and defense obligations of the Contractor, the "Contractor" shall provide at its own cost and expense proof of the following insurance* to the City of Northfield:

Commercial General Liability \$1,000,000 Automobile Liability \$1,000,000 Workers Compensation Statutory

Failure by the Contractor to supply such written evidence of required insurance and to maintain same for the duration of this contract shall result in default under this contract.

The insurance companies for the above coverages must be licensed by the State of New Jersey and acceptable to the City of Northfield. The "Contractor" shall take no action to cancel or materially change any of the insurance required under this Contract without the City of Northfield's prior approval. The maintenance of insurance under this section shall not relieve the "Contractor" of any liability greater than the limits or scope of the applicable insurance coverage.
